

# Important Announcement from the Secretary-Treasurer regarding Account Charges



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As work has returned to our states and several large projects are gearing up, we will move forward with our regular financial schedule. Please take a moment to review these important announcements about upcoming member obligations.

**Beginning on October 1st quarterly dues will again be charged.** If you have previously paid for the year or have earned a credit by completing the online training videos, no action may be required. I encourage you to visit your account via the website and check your balance. Take the time to update any contact information that may have changed over our long period off.

Over the summer, we completed a number of audits from past shows and seasons. The process of auditing these shows and collecting the data is a slow one, made even slower by remote work from the payroll companies. A number of members will owe 3% in work dues from these audits. **On October 1st we will update members accounts to reflect these charges.**

We understand that for many, these invoices come at a difficult time following a long period of unemployment. While not everyone will be able to make an immediate payment, with work returning, we will expect all members to pay these debts, either in full or with a payment plan. **Members who wish to set up payment plans can reach out to me.** I will work with any member directly to help avoid expulsion.

Elections for Local 484 Officers and Representatives are taking place as usual at the end of the year. **To be eligible to vote in these elections, you must be a member in Good Standing by November 30th.** To be in Good Standing you must not have an outstanding balance older than thirty days. Please take this into consideration when paying any outstanding debt.

As you return to work, please remember to fill out the 3% deduction forms. Many of the accounting departments have moved to digital start work. If 3% forms are not provided, please get in touch with the office immediately.
